Originally built as a hunting lodge for Louis XIII, the Château de Versailles was transformed and extended by his son, Louis XIV, into an opulent official royal residence, housing the Court and the Government from 1682 to 1789.

The best architects, painters, sculptors, gardeners, musicians and writers of the era gathered here to create the capital of both politics and the arts.

Saved by Louis-Philippe in the 19th century, then restored and refurbished during the 20th century, the vast estate (850 hectares) includes a park, 2 gardens, 1 palace, 2 chateaux, 1 opera house, 1 museum – all devoted to culture and the arts, relaxation, entertainment and leisure pursuits.

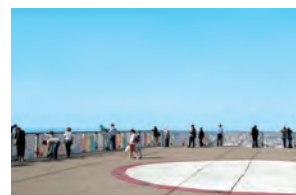

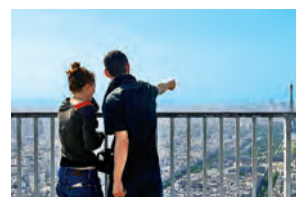
